Cumberland Plateau Planning District Commission (CPPDC) is offering economic recovery funding to businesses located within the Cumberland Plateau and LENOWISCO planning districts that were impacted by the 2020 pandemic. The CARES Act Revolving Loan Fund is a **low-interest loan program** designed to assist area businesses with COVID-related expenses and deficits resulting from negative impacts of the pandemic, including but not limited to lost revenue, supply chain interruptions, changes in how business is conducted and other adjustments brought on by COVID-19 conditions. - Interest rates from zero to four percent available
- Eligible costs: Site prep, engineering, machinery and equipment, working capital, other costs
- \$250,000 maximum funding request; maximum repayment term of 10 years
- Funds must be used for COVID-related business expenses
- Lien on fixed assets is required for collateral
- Deadline to apply: June 2022
